It should come with a power cord, instructions and starter ink cartridges. Carefully examine all the parts of the printer to make sure you have removed all protective tape and stickers. Place the printer within range of your Wi-Fi router or access point. (Most have a range of about 50 feet.) Most printers require you to set up the software with basic information and then wait for the ink cartridges to run tests and align. To connect your printer to your network, you need your network name (often called the SSID) and password. If your printer has a button labeled WSP or with the Wi-Fi icon, press it and then quickly go to your router and press the same button (within two minutes).
